

HEDIS® Measures 2018 Tips: Immunizations for Adolescents

Measure Description

Adolescents 13 years of age who received the following vaccines on or before their 13th birthday:

- One meningococcal conjugate vaccine (must be completed on or between the 11th and 13th birthdays).
- One tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine (must be completed on or between the 10th and 13th birthdays).
- The human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series on or between the 9th and 13th birthdays.

Exclusions

- Anaphylactic reaction to the vaccine or its components any time on or before the member's 13th birthday.

How to Improve HEDIS® Documentation

Make office visits count.

- Document any vaccines that were given prior to being seen at your office/practice.
- Document and code antigen given, date given and signature of person administering the immunization list to identify patients that need immunizations.
- HPV is now recommended for both males and females.
- Code appropriately using the code list below. Correct coding may prevent medical record requests.
- Document any parent refusal for immunizations.
- For the two-dose HPV vaccination series, there must be at least 146 days between the first and second dose of the HPV vaccine.
