EMERGENCY RELIEF

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Montana (BCBSMT) supported firefighting efforts and those affected by 2021 wildfires with \$35,000 from our emergency relief fund. The Cascade County Rural Fire Council and Lewis and Clark County Rural Fire Council each received \$5,000, and the American Red Cross of Montana received \$25,000. Nearly 940,000 acres burned in Montana during last year's fire season.





IMPROVING ACCESS TO CARE

To help address high rates of depression and suicide in Montana, BCBSMT continued its partnership with education technology company EVERFI to provide a mental health education program for middle and high school students statewide. About 2,500 students at 46 schools across Montana have used EVERFI's Mental Wellness Basics course since 2020. The course offers outcomes-based learning tools to engage students and help spark conversations about mental health and coping strategies to combat stigmas and promote health improvement.
