What is the overall deductible?	In-Network: \$9,100 Individual / \$18,200 Family Out-of-Network: \$36,400 Individual / \$72,800 Family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. In-Network Preventive Care services, services with a copayment, and hospice are covered before you meet your deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes. Inpatient Out-of-Network \$2,000; Outpatient Surgery Facility Out-of-Network \$2,000. There are no other specific deductibles. What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan? If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Premiums, balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
Will you pay less if you use a network provider?	Yes. See www.bcbsmt.com or call 1-855-258-8471 for a list of In-Network providers.	This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider, and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

Excluded Services & Other Covered Services:

Services Your Plan Generally Does NOT Cover (Check your policy or plan document for more information and a list of any other excluded services.)

- Abortion (except where a pregnancy is the result of rape or incest, or for a pregnancy which, as certified by a physician, places the woman in danger of death unless an abortion is performed)
- Bariatric surgery
- Dental care (Adult)
- Hearing aids (except for dependent children under age 19 and limited to 1 per ear every 3 years, and medically necessary cochlear implants, per medical policy)
- Long-term care
- Non-emergency care when traveling outside the U.S.
- Private-duty nursing
- Routine eye care (Adult)
- Routine foot care (except when medically necessary)
- Weight loss programs (with the exception of preventive services)

Other Covered Services (Limitations may apply to these services. This isn't a complete list. Please see your plan document.)

- Acupuncture (12-visit maximum per benefit period)
- Chiropractic care (10-visit maximum per benefit period)
- Cosmetic surgery (only for the correction of congenital deformities or conditions resulting from accidental injuries, scars, tumors, or diseases)
- Infertility treatment (with the exception of in vitro fertilization and prescription medications)

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
